Week 11: Management. Week 12: Partnership, Limited Partnership. Week 13, 14: Limited Liability Company. Week 15-18: Joint Stock Company. Week 19: Mergers. Week 20: Division; transformation. Week 21: Termination of economic entities - reasons, deletion of entities based on a statement of will, liquidation. Week 22-23: Bankruptcy. Week 24: Connecting legal entities based on investments in share capital and agreements on the assignment of management rights. Week 25: Connected legal entities, Holding, Concern, Consortium, Cartel and Joint Venture. Week 26-27: Competition Law. Week 28: Public enterprises; Cooperatives. Week 29: Status-legal relations of different categories of persons (founders with other persons). Week 30: Status-legal relations of the shareholders with other persons and other categories with each other (participants, employees, stakeholders).
