- 11th WEEK: Criminal offences against the constitutional order and security of the Republic of Serbia, criminal offences against state authorities and criminal offences against the judiciary;
- 12th WEEK: Criminal offences against public order and criminal offences against legal instruments;
- 13th WEEK: Criminal offences against public duty;
- 14th WEEK: Criminal offences against humanity and other values protected by the international law:
- 15th WEEK: Criminal offences against the military of Serbia.
