Course aim: Students will acquire theoretical and practically applicable knowledge about the characteristics of criminal acts from the so-called special part of the criminal legislation of the Republic of Serbia.		
Course outcome: Students will be trained to apply criminal law provisions in practice (in terms of determining the legal qualification of criminal offences, proper delineation of offenses with similar characteristics, distinguishing basic, more serious or lighter forms of individual offences, ways of determining factual and subjective characteristics of offences, etc.).		
Course contents: 1 st WEEK: Criminal offences against life and physical integrity; 2 nd WEEK: Criminal offences against life and physical integrity; 3 rd WEEK: Criminal offences against freedoms, the rights of man and citizens' rights, criminal offences against electoral rights and criminal offences against labour rights; 4 th WEEK: Criminal offences against honour and reputation, sexual criminal offences and criminal offences against marriage and family; 5 th WEEK: Criminal offences against property; 6 th WEEK: Criminal offences against property; 7 th WEEK: Criminal offences against intellectual property; criminal offences against security of computer data and criminal offences against economy interests; 8 th WEEK: Criminal offences against human health and criminal offences environment; 9 th WEEK: Criminal offences against general safety of people and property; 10 th WEEK: Criminal offences against the safety of the public traffic; 11 th WEEK: Criminal offences against the constitutional order and security of the Republic of Serbia, criminal offences against state authorities and criminal offences against the judiciary; 12 th WEEK: Criminal offences against public order and criminal offences against legal instruments; 13 th WEEK: Criminal offences against public duty; 14 th WEEK: Criminal offences against humanity and other values protected by the international law; 15 th WEEK: Criminal offences against the military of Serbia.
